Pursuant to Administrative Order No. 2014-1, Petitioner Evan S. Gutman requests Emergency Treatment for his filing this day concurrently submitted that is titled "REQUEST FOR RULING ON PENDING PETITION FOR WRIT OF PROHIBITION and RULING ON PENDING ATTORNEY FEE APPEAL." Pursuant to the Administrative Order the applicable information follows:

Par. 2(a) - Nature of Emergency - Judge Edward A. Garrison indicated that Petitioner may be incarcerated by the end of this day April 19, 2024. Also as indicated in the applicable Request filed concurrently and describing this matter in greater detail, Judge Garrison indicated on April 3, 2024, that if Petitioner is incarcerated he may suffer physical injury, which he described as follows: **"If you want to have one foot on the banana peel and your neck in a noose, that's entirely up to you."** (See Page 85 of Transcript in Separate Filing submitted this day containing the Request).

Par. 2(b) - Date the Order at Issue was Entered - The Order delineating the events at the Hearing on April 3, 2024 was entered on April 8, 2024.

Par. 2(c) - The Hearing was held on April 3, 2024, which is the date of the event constituting the basis for the emergency. It was on that date that Judge Garrison spoke the applicable words.

Par. 2(d) - The applicable deadline is Friday, April 19, 2024 at 5:00 p.m.
Extensive details of this matter and the applicable Transcript are included in Petitioner's Request for Ruling on Pending Petition for Writ of Prohibition and Ruling on Pending Attorney Fee Appeal, filed this same day.

Based on the foregoing and as delineated in the separate Request for a Ruling on the Pending Petition for Writ of Prohibition, Petitioner submits this Request for Emergency Treatment. Petitioner Certifies this Request is made in Good Faith.
